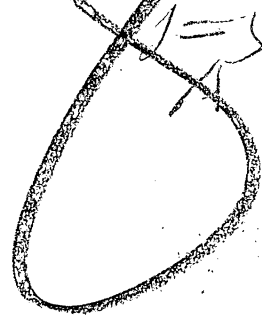
That the area bounded by Plymouth Street,
