Over more than a dozen years, the firm has been responsible for the design and coordination of the restoration work of this eighteenth century architectural masterpiece, originally designed by Peter Harrison and subsequently enlarged and decorated by Ware and van Burnt. The work has included:

1. A total survey of the entire structure and subsequent treatment of infested timbers and structural reinforcement as needed.
2. Resheathing of the tower with a weeping system to protect the structure from rot, a new copper roof, installation of a lightning rod concealed in the orb and cross and refurbishing of the thirteen bells. After historical research, the three pairs of entrance doors were returned to their original appearance.
3. Reslating of the church roof and reestablishment of the original pitch of the roof of the apse.
4. Documentation of the painting history of the interior and a new color choice made based on eighteenth century precedent.
5. A grounds development plan which provided for the separation of church and rectory traffic.
6. A memorial wall constructed as a contemporary equivalent of the old church yard cemetery.
