

CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

In Common Council, Feb. 26, 1879.

The Joint Committee on Printing, which was instructed to consider and report upon the expediency of preparing a revised arrangement of the City Ordinances, the Rules and Orders of the City Council and the amended Charter of the City:—also such of the General Statutes and Special Laws of the Commonwealth as may relate more particularly to the city:—also to estimate the number of copies of such revised arrangement necessary to be printed, and the probable cost thereof,

Reports

That your Committee finds on enquiry that there is only a very limited number of copies of the last revision of the City Ordinances, now on hand, and it therefore appears to be expedient that the Ordinances and Joint Rules should be reprinted in a new revision. The addition to such a reprint,

of the General and Special Laws relating to our city, would make an expensive and bulky volume, and your Committee is of the opinion that it is inexpedient to cause such laws to be printed. A careful estimate of the cost of reprinting the City Charter, Ordinances, and Joint Rules, as revised and amended, has been made by two of the largest printing houses in the city, as follows:

For 500 copies	_____	\$ 300.—

For each 8 pages in excess of these numbers:  
 If 500 copies are printed \$12.— for each 8 pages.

and if the number of pages fall short of 200 pages, the same amount will be deducted. This estimate does not include the cost of revision, which the Committee feels, ought to be done without additional expense to the city. Your Committee would here with recommend the adoption of accompanying order authorizing the revision and reprinting of the City Ordinances in accordance with the views herein presented.
