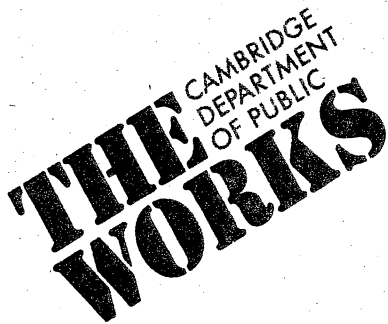

This notice is to inform you that NStar (formerly known as ComGas) plans to replace their existing cast iron gas main and service lines with new plastic lines in Eustis Street starting Monday, April 2, 2001. This work was postponed from last fall. **The procedure is expected to take 4 weeks to complete.** The main will be replaced in the first two weeks, followed by service replacement for the last two weeks. The new gas main replacement is a component of the Sewer Separation and Storm Water Management project.

**You will receive advanced notice of NStar's replacement of the gas service to your property. As part of the service replacement, the gas service to your home will be temporarily disrupted and you will have to coordinate with NStar to re-light your pilot light prior to restoring service.**

Eustis Street will be open to abutter traffic and driveways should be assessible during this work with the assistance of police detail officers. Normal traffic patterns will resume at the completion of each work day.

NStar will post "No Parking" signs, where necessary, at least 24 hours before this work begins. Please refrain from parking in these areas during the posted work hours of 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
