Several changes of street and square names have been made by City Council action. One of these needs clarification.

An order in City Council, dated May 3, 1948, named the intersection of Sparks Street and Huron Avenue as Kelley Square. This square is already named Wyman Square, date of order March 26, 1903.

Also we already have a Kelley Square at the junction of Bridge and Gore Streets, date of order October 2, 1900.

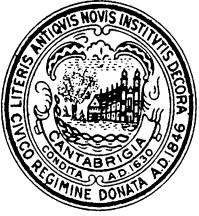

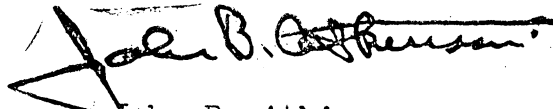
