The Committee on *Roads and Bridges,*

to which was referred the ~~petition~~ matter of the widening extension and laying out of Front Street as an avenue of approach to the Haward Bridge,

Reports,

Recommending the

adoption of the accompanying order, viz: an order making a partial appropriation of the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars, to meet immediate demands for expenditure on account of said widening extension and laying out of Front Street, and providing for the creation of a City debt for a like sum, bearing interest at the rate of not exceeding four per cent per annum, and payable in not exceeding thirty years from a date within the current year, - the same being in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 155 of the acts of the year 1882, and any subsequent acts in relation to the same subject. Also, an order authorizing the Mayor to draw his warrant upon the City Treasurer in payment of each of the awards for damages made in the order

for by parties to whom such awards were made.

Inasmuch as some of these awards are likely to be
accepted and called for before the next meeting of
the City Council, following the summer adjournment,
