Locations on Mason St.

- #1. A pole on South side of Mason St. in front of a ^{on the} tree set into the fence
- #2. A tree on South side next the line of the school yard
- #3. A pole on South side at the North-west ^(mid-way between the armory + the C.B.) corner of the school-yard
- #4. A pole on South side in front of the dividing line between ^{(on square) line of the north building} #4 & #6.
- #5. A pole on the North side five feet beyond the catch-basin

Locations on North Ave.

- #1. A pole on South-westely corner of Cedar St. and R. R. Crossing
- #2 A pole on North-westely Corner of Cedar St and R. R. Crossing
- #3 A pole on South-westely side of North Ave. at Easterly corner of Black-smiths Shop
- #4. A pole on North-eastely side already located for Fire Alarm.
- #5 & 6. Two poles on same side as the above already located for Fire Alarm
7. A pole on South westely side between D. J. Sullivans B. S. Shop and house
8. & 9 Two poles on South-westely side so located as to about equally divide the space between Location 7 & 10.
- #10 A tree at North-eastely corner of Tannery St.
11. A pole midway between locations 10 & 12
- 12 A tree on North-eastely side of Avenue
- 13, 14, 15, 16, 17. poles so located on the North eastely side as to divide the distance Arlington line into five equal spaces.
