In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred
and Seventy Four,

An Ordinance in amendment of the
"Ordinance in relation to Streets."

Be it ordained by the City Council of
the City of Cambridge, as follows:

Section Eight of Chapter Twenty Five, of
the Revised Ordinances is hereby amended,
by adding thereto the words,

— And in case of the blockade or ob-
struction of any street, lane or alley, he shall
cause a notification of such blockade
or obstruction to be left at each of the
several engine houses throughout the City.—
