"Should the Cambridge City Council support a national health service program which: provides comprehensive care including preventive, curative and occupational health services; is community controlled, rationally organized, equitably financed, with no out-of-pocket charges; is universal in coverage and sensitive to the particular health needs of elderly, women, minorities and disabled persons."
