VICE-MAYOR RUSSELL

ORDERED:

That a license is hereby granted to Townsend Limousine Service under the provisions of Chapter 159A of the Massachusetts General Laws for the operation of two buses for the carriage of passengers and military personnel to be conveyed from Fort Devens to Logan Airport over the following public ways in the City of Cambridge:

Concord Turnpike (Route 2) between the Cambridge-Belmont Town Line and Alewife Brook Parkway,
Rindge Avenue Extension between Alewife Brook Parkway and its termination point,
then back onto Alewife Brook Parkway, Fresh Pond Parkway and Memorial Drive to its destination at Logan Airport and return from Logan Airport by the same route;

and be it further

ORDERED:

That this license be granted with the following provisions:

1. That these vehicles will make no stops within the City of Cambridge for the pick up and discharge of passengers, except at the Rindge Avenue Extension location for military and project personnel.
2. That no more than two buses of twelve passenger capacity will operate on this route.
3. That no more than four trips daily will be made by these buses.
4. That any and all changes in the conditions outlined above are subject to the approval of the City Council;

and be it further

ORDERED:

That this license is granted subject to the condition that Townsend Limousine Service file with the City Clerk a schedule each year of all passenger rates, routes and any amendments thereto in the future;
and be it further

ORDERED:

That the City Council reserves the right to revoke the license granted in the event of the breach of any conditions outlined above.

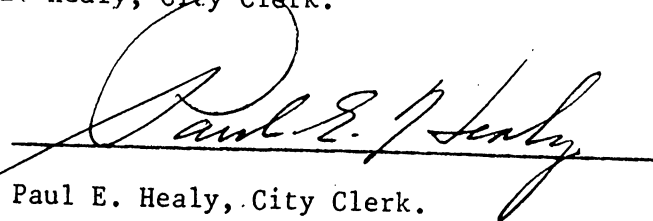
