In Board of Aldermen, April 22, 1861.

Resolved, That the public convenience and necessity require that Remington Street from Main Street to Howard Street, should be laid out as a public highway:-

Ordered, That Remington Street, from Main Street to Howard Street, be accepted and laid out as a public highway, forty feet in width, as delineated on a Plan drawn by W. A. Chase and W. S. Barbour, Surveyors, dated July 10, 1860, now on file in the office of the City Clerk, which Plan is hereby adopted by this Board.
