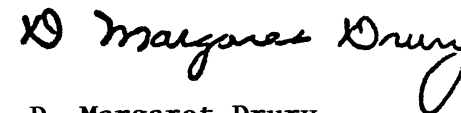

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$2,915.00 in the General Fund of the Peace Commission Other Ordinary Maintenance Account from ticket sales. The Cambridge Peace Commission sponsored the Fifth Annual Peace and Justice Awards Dinner on October 24, 1999. The evening consisted of a dinner and ceremony honoring 29 citizens or groups who have contributed to building a safer more equitable City. Recipients range from neighborhood activists to church supporters to setters of national policy. Approximately 175 people attended at a cost of \$15.00 per ticket for adults and \$5.00 for children.
