- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Albert E. Lynch, MD, retired Cambridge Gynecologist and Obstetrician at the Mount Auburn Hospital; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Lynch, a lifelong Cambridge resident, attended local public schools, graduating from Harvard College in 1945 and from the Tufts Medical School in 1947; and
- WHEREAS: Having completed four years of training in obstetrics and gynecology at Boston City Hospital, he joined the staff of the Mount Auburn Hospital, and later opened a private practice from which he retired in August of 1985; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Lynch served his country both during World War II as a member of the United States Army, and during the Korean Conflict as a member of the United States Air Force; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the family of Dr. Albert E. Lynch at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy to the family of Dr. Lynch, on behalf of the entire City Council.
