

In Common Council May 3rd 1874

Ordered that the committee on Roads and Bridges consider the expediency of building and locating a temporary floating bridge across the Charles River at a point between the eastern terminus of Bridge St. in Cambridge and the Pier east of the channel in Boston. The same being for the accommodation of the numerous working people who have occasion to cross from the one city to the other and who would be otherwise considerably inconvenienced during the rebuilding of Long Bridge
