Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:—

The Ordinance in relation to Finance is amended in Section 1, by striking out in the second and third lines thereof, the words "for the payment of principal or interest due on any note or other security of the City of Cambridge", and substituting after the word "appropriated" in the second line, the words, "by a vote of the City Council".
