

FINAL STATEMENT OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT OBJECTIVES
AND PROJECTED USE OF FUNDS - BLOCK GRANT/JOBS BILL FUNDING
CAMBRIDGE, MASSACHUSETTS

I. COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT OBJECTIVES

The following three Cambridge objectives are those established by Congress under Title I of Public Law 98-3 (97 Stat. 13) (the "Jobs Bill") for community development activities under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974.

1. Provide productive employment for jobless Americans.
2. Hasten or initiate Federal projects and construction.
3. Provide humanitarian assistance to the indigent.

Three further objectives implied by the Jobs Bill are:

4. Spend Jobs Bill funds as rapidly as practical.
5. Fund programs that will become self-sustaining.
6. Fund programs that will teach specific job skills.

Additionally, insofar as consistent with the above objectives, the City proposes to use the "Jobs Bill" with \$765,000 Block Grant Program funding for projects consistent with the five standard objectives of the Cambridge Block Grant Program. These five standard objectives were published in the Cambridge Chronicle of March 3, 1983, and are now available at the City Manager's Office, City Clerk's Office, and the Community Development Department, as part of the City's CDBG Year #9 "Final Statement of Community Development Objectives and Projected Use of Funds." In abbreviated form, the five objectives are:

OBJECTIVE #1 - Stabilize the City's Population

OBJECTIVE #2 - Enhance the Quality of the City's Physical Environment

OBJECTIVE #3 - Preserve the City's Diversified Employment Base

OBJECTIVE #4 - Improve the Quality of Public Services

OBJECTIVE #5 - Strengthen the City's Fiscal Base

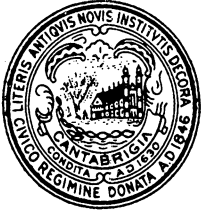
