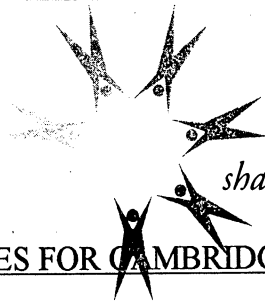

TRANSPORTATION RESOURCES FOR CAMBRIDGE ELDERS

CAMBRIDGE TAXI CAB COUPON PROGRAM: Taxi discount coupons, funded by the City of Cambridge, are offered free of charge to Cambridge residents who are sixty years of age or older. Riders must use a licensed Cambridge taxi company and each coupon is worth \$1.75. The elder can use one coupon for fares under \$5.00 and two coupons for fares over \$5.00. A maximum of two coupons can be used for any one-way trip, regardless of the fare. Phone-in registration is possible. Individuals registering by phone will have to send proof of eligibility to the registering agency. For information on registration for the Coupon Program contact the Cambridge Council on Aging at **349-6220**.

CAMBRIDGE COUNCIL ON AGING SHUTTLE BUS: The Cambridge COA provides transportation at various pick up points throughout the City to the City Wide Senior Center, located at 806 Massachusetts Ave. This service is available M-F, 8:30-5:00. For more information, call the Cambridge Council on Aging at **349-6055**.

CAMBRIDGE COUNCIL ON AGING MALL SHOPPING: On the second, third and fourth Fridays of the month, the COA pickups seniors at various housing developments and transports to area malls. A donation of \$1.25 is requested. For additional information call **349-6055**.

SCM COMMUNITY TRANSPORTATION, INC.: Resident of Cambridge, Somerville, and Medford 60 years of age or older or disabled can call for curb to curb rides for local non-emergency medical appointments and grocery shopping. A minimum of 48 hours notice must be given. SCM will accept reservations up to thirty days in advance. SCM provides shuttle services to most of the local hospitals in Boston. Shuttle service is Monday through Friday, 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. Medical appointments must be made for 9:00 am or after and be finished by 2:00 pm. SCM charges a fee of \$1.00 each way within the cities they serve, \$2.00 each way for shuttle service to hospitals within the Boston area. Drivers will help a passenger up or down from the curb and/or to or from one step. SCM will not provide wheelchair carry-down services. Escorts are allowed to accompany an elder. Scheduling hours for transportation is Monday through Friday, 9:00 am to 1:00 pm. SCM can be reached at **(617)625-1191**.

MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSIT AUTHORITY (MBTA): Discount fares for Senior Citizens sixty-five years of age or older. A picture ID can be obtained at the MBTA Senior and Access Pass Office, located at the Back Bay Station, 145 Dartmouth St., Boston. The office is open Monday through Friday, 8:30 am to 5:00 pm. Requirements for ID Card are: proof of age 65 or older, e.g. birth certificate, baptismal

record, citizenship papers or driver's license. Proof of residency, driver's license or gas/electric bill. For more information call **(617)222-5438**.

THE RIDE: Seniors and/or disabled individuals unable to use public transportation due to difficulty with either walking, seeing, using stairs or escalator, or riding in a standard transit vehicle and who are registered with the MBTA Office for Transportation Access can receive door to door transportation for any type of trip. A form must be completed by a licensed/certified human service or health care professional who is familiar with the individual and his or her disability. The individual must have a disability which prevents using public transportation and must reside within The Ride service area. The Ride is a first come first serve service. Registration must be made for transportation service. Fee for service is through the purchase of booklet of tickets which is for four round trips for one person. Each ticket is \$1.00. All vehicles are equipped to carry both ambulatory persons and individuals in wheelchairs. The driver will help a passenger up or down from curb and/or up or down from one step. Escort can accompany individuals. The MBTA Office for Transportation Access is located at: 10 Park Plaza, Room 4730, Boston, MA 02116. MASSHEALTH TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM: This service is for non-emergency medical trips only. Service is available to MassHealth (Medicaid benefits) clients including CommonHealth and Mass. Commission for the Blind. EAEDC clients are not eligible for the service. Transportation service to medical appointments when an individual is unable to access public or private transportation. Doctor or medical provider must authorize the need for transportation by completing a Prescription for Transportation (PT-1) Form. A separate PT-1 Form must be submitted for each medical provider a client visits. Once approved, individuals must call, at least, 3 days in advance of scheduled appointment. KIDNEY TRANSPLANT/DIALYSIS ASSOCIATION, INC.: Will reimburse transportation cost to any individual who is undergoing dialysis. Individuals should request a Patient Assistance Grant Application at their place of dialysis treatment. The application has a section to be completed by the medical social worker. All receipts for transportation cost incurred must be submitted with the application. All applications are reviewed by a committee for approval. Decisions about reimbursement take 1 to 2 months. WHEELCHAIR VANS: Ambulance Services often have wheelchair van service. Check the Yellow Pages for local companies. Chisholm Chair Car, Professional Ambulance, Handi-Trans, Cataldo Chair Car/Ambulance, and Accessible Transportation, Co. are a few. The rider would be paying privately for any non-emergency ride.

THE SHEPHERD'S CENTER OF CAMB./SOM. : Escort transportation is available to persons 60 and older and/or disabled individuals. For more information, call **354-9515**.
