WHEREAS: The Women's Educational and Industrial Union will present this year's Amelia Earhart Award on October 23, 1997 at the Boston Park Plaza Hotel to Eileen Moran Brown; and

WHEREAS: This Award is presented to a woman in the Greater Boston area who continues the pioneering spirit of Amelia Earhart and who has contributed to the advancement of opportunities for other women; and

WHEREAS: **Eileen Moran Brown** began her career as an English teacher in an inner-city Philadelphia school; and

WHEREAS: Throughout the sixties, Brown worked to build programs for Philadelphia's inner-city schools. She coordinated a federally funded project aimed at developing the college potential in students from the inner-city; and

WHEREAS: Eileen also worked with the University of Pennsylvania and the Philadelphia Public Schools to prepare teachers to meet the needs of urban children, schools, and communities; and

WHEREAS: Twenty-five years ago **Eileen Moran Brown** helped found Cambridge College, which is dedicated to providing outstanding higher education to a diverse population of working adults. She has also served as a consultant to many institutions and organizations on career development and leadership, with a special emphasis on building women's leadership skills; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the entire City Council go on record as congratulating Eileen Moran Brown for all her efforts in improving the lives of untold numbers of students.
