IN CITY COUNCIL
September 13, 1938

WHEREAS:

Under date of August 9, 1938, an appropriation order in the amount of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) was adopted by the City Council for the construction and equipment of a library building, said order having been approved by His Honor the Mayor on August 10, 1938, and

WHEREAS:

There is included in said sum, in addition to the estimated cost of construction and equipment, an amount sufficient to meet the cost of the acquisition of the land necessary, it is

ORDERED:

That His Honor, the Mayor, be and hereby is authorized to acquire by purchase the following described land, to wit:

"Beginning at a point at the intersection of the northerly line of Thorndike Street and easterly line of Sixth Street, then northerly along said easterly line of Sixth Street 100.36 feet to a point, thus easterly by a straight line 100 feet to a point, thus southerly by a straight line 100.19 feet to a point in the aforementioned northerly line to Thorndike Street, thus easterly along said northerly side of Thorndike Street 100 feet to the point of beginning; containing 10,027 $\frac{1}{2}$ square feet, the above described parcel of land as shown on the Public Property Plan Volume, Page 12, on file in the office of the City Engineer.

and it is further

ORDERED:

That His Honor, the Mayor, ^{be} and hereby is authorized to pay to the Roman Catholic Archbishop of Boston the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) in full settlement for the land hereinbefore described.
