To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached please find for your review and action an order requesting the acceptance and appropriation of a grant in the amount of \$7,000.00 from Somerville-Cambridge Elder Services, Inc. to the Department of Human Service Programs, Grant Fund, Other Ordinary Maintenance account.

This grant will provide consumer advocacy to 2,000 Cambridge and Somerville elders. The Consumer Council will provide consumer information and representation, conduct training sessions, produce a consumer services guide and attempt to resolve elderly consumer complaints without recourse to legal proceedings.

The contract with Somerville-Cambridge Elder Services, Inc. requires that this grant be split evenly between the Consumer Councils of Cambridge and Somerville.
