In Board of Aldermen, Dec. 13th, 1871.

The Committee on Public Property authorized to purchase a lot of land on the corner of Pitt, Auburn and Elliott Streets for a Police Court room, Station and Engine House,

Report, that the owners of the land require as a condition in selling, that the City shall widen Elliott Street on its southerly side to a line corresponding with the southerly line of Bennett Street; and as the Order relative to such widening has been by concurrent vote indefinitely postponed, further present action by your Committee is uncalled for. They therefore recommend that the subject be referred to the next City Council.
