WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened at learning of the death of Reverend Ernest T. Serino on September 12, 1992; and

WHEREAS: Father Serino was born in Revere and grew up in Lynn, where he attended Lynn English High School before going on the graduate from St. Mary's Boys' High in Lynn; and

WHEREAS: Father Serino served in the Navy from 1946 to 1948 and then entered St. John's Seminary to study for the priesthood and was ordained in the Cathedral of the Holy Cross on February 2, 1956; and

WHEREAS: Father Serino's ministry included assignments as Associate Pastor at St. Rita's Parish in Haverhill, an academic year studying at the university of Puerto Rico in San Juan, and upon his return he became an assistant and later Director at the Cardinal Cushing Spanish Speaking Center of Boston until 1974; and

WHEREAS: From 1962-1970 he was also a part-time Chaplin to the Boston Juvenile Court and in 1974 he became Associate Pastor of St. John the Baptist Parish in Peabody and in 1976 he was named Pastor of St. Catherine of Siena Parish in Charlestown, where he served until 1981; and

WHEREAS: Father Serino's next assignment was Pastor of the Sacred Heart Parish in Watertown and left in 1992 to join the staff of the Boston Archdiocese's Office of Spiritual Development; and

WHEREAS: Father Serino was involved with Cursillo, teen encounters, retreats, marriage encounter, Cana and Pre-Cana; and

WHEREAS: Father Serino will sorely be missed by all he touched and loved; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the family of Reverend Ernest T. Serino at this time of such personal loss; and be it further

Rev. Ernest T. Serino, worked for archdiocese

The Rev. Ernest T. Serino of Cambridge, who worked in the Spiritual Development Office of the Archdiocese of Boston, died Saturday at St. Elizabeth's Hospital in Brighton after a brief illness. He was 64.

Born in Revere, he graduated from St. Mary's Boys High School in Lynn and St. John's Seminary in Brighton.

Rev. Serino served in the U.S. Navy during World War II.

Rev. Serino was ordained at Cathedral of the Holy Cross in Boston in 1956. He completed many assignments, including being an assistant at St. Rita in Haverhill, associate pastor at St. John the Baptist Church in Peabody and pastor at St. Catherine Church in Charlestown and at Sacred Heart Church in Watertown.

He had been active in Cursillo, teen encounters, retreats, marriage encounter and Cana and Pre-Cana.

He is survived by three brothers, James of St. Luis Obispo, Calif., and Anthony and Angelo, both of Lynn; three sisters, Rose Morretti of Saugus, Geraldine Diglio of Lynn, and Ann Kelliher of Swampscott; and many nieces and nephews.

A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Friday at Cathedral of the Holy Cross, Boston.

Burial will be in St. Joseph's Cemetery, Lynn.
