IN THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-

AN ACT abolishing the obligations of the City of Cambridge for maintenance costs of the drawbridges over the Broad Canal in the City of Cambridge

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 443 of the Acts of 1958 is hereby amended by adding the following to section two of said act: The obligations of the City of Cambridge to reimburse the Metropolitan District Commission for one third of the cost of salaries of the positions of the employees engaged in the operation of said drawbridges is repealed, and the City of Cambridge is hereby discharged from all obligations incurred under said act.

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
