

To the Honorable, the City Council:

The attached transfer of \$35,000 to the Public Works Department Other Ordinary Maintenance account from the Salaries and Wages account is for the development of a system of permanent "No Parking - Street Cleaning" signs to be installed this spring to replace the cardboard ones used in the past. This system will have metal signs placed adjacent to the Resident Parking signs on the same pole and bracket. The system will establish a schedule with a street being swept on the same day of the week each month.
