- WHEREAS: This City Council has, for several months, been deliberating the proposed rezoning petition regarding the Alewife area; and
- WHEREAS: This petition involves some 300 acres of land, which may constitute the largest rezoning petition ever considered by the Council; and
- WHEREAS: It is the sense of some members of this Council that more neighborhood and business input, including blue collar business, must be received prior to future consideration of this petition by the Council; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Community Development Department to conduct workshops for the City Council, neighborhood and business community in order to provide, in "layman's language", better understanding of this complicated zoning petition, said workshops should involve a complete history (including color coded maps) of what kind of development has been allowed in the past; what currently exists in this area; and what would be excluded from this area should the petition be adopted at a future time.
