RESOLUTION of the Cambridge City Council expressing concern over the possible passage of H.R. 4103, the "Cable Telecommunications Act of 1983", and further, expressing support for the United States Conference of Mayors in their efforts to defeat the passage of H.R. 4103 as it now stands.

- WHEREAS: The House of Representatives is presently debating the merits of H.R. 4103, the "Cable Telecommunications Act of 1983"; and
- WHEREAS: This bill prohibits local regulations of cable television rates; and
- WHEREAS: It provides for almost automatic franchise renewal, placing municipalities in the position of having to prove, in court, that cable operators have not met the terms of their contract; and
- WHEREAS: This bill permits only minimal standards for the protection from invasion of privacy; and
- WHEREAS: This bill permits the abrogation of contract provisions covering facilities and equipment and cable service and further, works against, rather than for, the public interest; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council voices its opposition to H.R. 4103 as it now stands; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the members of the Massachusetts Congressional Delegation be informed of this resolution.
