WHEREAS:

Many Cambridge residents have lost their jobs in the current recession, and

WHEREAS:

The State of Massachusetts is defaulting on its obligations to the poor and the unemployed, therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That to maintain the housing rights of the poor and unemployed, the City Council of Cambridge hereby orders the Rent Control Board of Cambridge to declare a moratorium on all rent increases for the next two years on any rent-controlled housing unit, and be it further

RESOLVED:

That some large apartment buildings will not be exempted from rent control while most are included, the City Council of Cambridge urges the General Court to amend Chapter 842 of the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts (the Rent Control Enabling Act) so as to bring all F. H. A. and M. H. F. A. subsidized buildings located in cities or towns that have adopted rent control under the provisions of Chapter 842.
