- WHEREAS: The final construction work on the new Huron Avenue Bridge is currently under way which, once completed, will again provide safe passage for motor vehicles traveling beyond Aberdeen Avenue; and
- WHEREAS: Through the diligent efforts of Mayor Leonard J. Russell, the project was given a high priority at the State and Federal level to ensure completion of this work in a timely manner, minimizing the inconvenience of the residents of this area; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record designating the Huron Avenue Bridge as the Mayor Leonard J. Russell Bridge, in recognition of his work and dedication to this project; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Commissioner of Public Works to prepare a suitable plaque to be erected at this location upon completion of the construction; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That His Honor, the Mayor, be and hereby is requested to appoint a Committee of three City Councillors in order to arrange for an appropriate ceremony.
