- WHEREAS: The City Councillors of the City of Cambridge, have passed a resolution declaring the period from November 12 through 18, 1989, as Cambridge Arts Week; and
- WHEREAS: The Cambridge Arts Council, eager to participate actively in Cambridge Arts Week, indicates that during that period, the Massachusetts Arts Lottery funded projects under its jurisdiction, which include, an exhibition of Chris Doogan's linoleum block prints portraying the homeless, performances by the Ballet Theatre of Boston, an artists' residency by carvers Loren White and Steven Brown at the Kennedy School, and an afternoon of Bahamian folk tales with Derek Burrows at local Cambridge libraries; and
- WHEREAS: The Third Annual Arts Achievement Awards will be presented to Lotus Development Corporation and Polaroid Corporation, as part of Cambridge Arts Week in recognition of their established history of support of the arts; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That I, Alfred E. Vellucci, Mayor of the City of Cambridge, proclaim the period from November 12 through 18, 1989, to be **CAMBRIDGE ARTS WEEK**, and urge the people of Cambridge to take advantage of the events planned by the Cambridge Arts Council and other Cambridge arts organizations; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to be forwarded to the Cambridge Arts Council, 57 Inman Street, Cambridge, MA 02139.
