Crowley, the same providing for the occupancy by her of the tract of land in the rear of the Brattle Square Building, known as Lot No 14, Assessors' Block Plan #165, at an annual rental of one hundred dollars (\$100.00), for a period of one year with a right to revoke lease after giving thirty days notice to the lessee.
