Dear Mr. Corcoran:

I enclosed herewith for presentation to the City Council and submission on petition of the City Council to the General Court proposed legislation designed to alleviate the burden to the taxpayers of the recent disorders in the City and to spare the City of future expense should such disorders arise in the future.

The first proposed bill seeks to authorize the Commonwealth to reimburse the City for the expenses incurred on April 15 and May 8, 1970.

The second seeks to amend General Laws, Chapter 269, Section 8 to transfer responsibility for any such loss to the Commonwealth.

The third would amend Chapter 44, Section 99 to place the cost of bringing in outside police to any city or town in the Commonwealth.

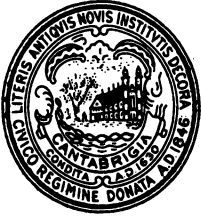
