
Dear Madame Mayor and Members of the City Council:

We therefore ask that you instruct the City Manager to direct the appropriate city departments to take any action necessary to disallow this company from operating on this property. We know that you will look favorably upon our request because of your past concern for the environmental quality of our neighborhood. Thank you for your prompt and favorable consideration of this matter.
