**TO THE HONORABLE MEMBERS OF THE CAMBRIDGE CITY COUNCIL**

Cambridge ACCESS Jobs, Inc. is a five year old job placement, education and training organization serving the City of Cambridge. Founded in response to the Minority Employment Initiatives Program of the Legislative Black Caucus, ACCESS has the unique mandate of serving people of color and linguistic minorities, a group not well served by traditional employment and training agencies. Although other employment programs exist in Cambridge, none have a similar mission. Indeed, ACCESS' services are not replicated anywhere in the Cambridge area. The fact that ACCESS does not consist of a duplication of services is indicated by the number of linguistic minorities and people of color that are referred each week by these other organizations who are unable to serve them.

Employment projections indicate that this target group will represent, by the year 2010, the majority of all new workers entering the job market. Yet today, it is the group which is experiencing the highest chronic rate of unemployment and underemployment. The current state of the Massachusetts economy places people of color and linguistic minorities in even greater jeopardy in the job market than in the last three years. In fact, the most recent unemployment figures indicate that the unemployment rate for minorities is over 25%. The productivity of the American economy in future years will depend in large measure upon the resolution to this pressing manpower problem.

Cambridge ACCESS serves a population which is outside the economic mainstream and, without intervention, is likely to continue to be excluded from full participation in the local job market. Its obstacles to employment are varied and serious, including particularly:

- Lack of English Language Proficiency
- Illiteracy in Native Language
- Very Little or No Work History
- Inadequate Job Skills
- Discrimination and Cross-Cultural/Human Relations Problems in the Workplace

With a community-based Board of Directors and a professional and racially and ethnically diverse staff, ACCESS has developed a strong track record of success in assisting this challenging group. Of the 4,374 program participants served in the first 48 months of operations (July 1986 - June 1990), 2,939, or 67.2%, have achieved successful outcomes: 2,204 were placed in permanent employment (323 also received educational services and 235 also received training), 353 completed educational courses and 382 participated in skills training programs.

In Fiscal Year 1991 Cambridge ACCESS received \$25,000 from the City of Cambridge which enabled it to provide an array of interrelated employment and educational services to people of color and linguistic minorities residing in the City of Cambridge. As a result, ACCESS secured employment for one hundred and thirty-five (135) residents of Cambridge, eighty-three (83) attended English As A Second Language and an additional one hundred and thirty (130) attended a variety of employment related and skills training workshops (e.g., motivation, interpersonal and communication skills and team building).

In fact, the issues that Cambridge ACCESS has been addressing since its inception are among

the key problems identified by Cambridge employers in a Preliminary Findings of the Community Development Department Employer Survey entitled **Jobs, Training, and the Evolving Cambridge Economy** which was issued last month.

Cambridge ACCESS' success results from its unique employment strategy which approaches the workplace as a social and cultural phenomenon, not only a place of economic activity. People of color and linguistic minorities frequently encounter discrimination and cross-cultural/human relations problems on the job; their successful resolution is essential to long-term employment success. ACCESS staff include human relations specialists who counsel individual clients, arrange special client/employer sessions to address issues of cultural differences or organize workshops for the entire workforce--whatever intervention is required to solve the problem.

Cambridge ACCESS' success also results from its pre-employment, education and training programs which provide each participant with individualized and tailor-made services including one-to-one counseling, job readiness and job retention workshops in the appropriate language, adult basic education, literacy and English As A Second Language, clerical skills training and word processing.

Initially funded by an annual \$300,000 state legislative appropriation to serve any person of color or linguistic minority regardless of income or educational background, ACCESS Jobs has been expanding its funding base to include other governmental agencies. Its recent government funding, however, has been increasingly tied to contracts for services for restricted groups (e.g. Unemployment Insurance claimants and recipients of AFDC). In fiscal year 1990, \$200,000, or 66% of ACCESS' state budget, was earmarked for restricted groups and only \$100,000, or 33%, was unrestricted. In fiscal year 1991, which started July 1, 1990, unrestricted funds were cut from \$100,000 to \$37,400 while restricted funds were reduced from \$200,000 to \$98,500--*a total cutback of \$164,100, from \$300,000 to \$135,900, which represented a 55% reduction in state funding. At the same time, 1888 persons sought ACCESS' services in Fiscal Year 1991 which represents a 37% increase from last year's 1380 for the same period. At a time when ACCESS' services are most needed, cutbacks have precipitated drastic reductions in staff.*

Although Cambridge ACCESS was not included in the FY '92 state budget, it has nonetheless diversified its funding base through an increase in philanthropic and corporate support. ACCESS has already received funds from five private sources and several foundations have indicated their interest in supporting Cambridge ACCESS' program. However, ACCESS also requires support from the City of Cambridge. This support is crucial if ACCESS Jobs is to continue to fulfill its mission to serve its diverse and unique target population--unemployed and underemployed people of color and linguistic minorities--who rely on ACCESS for training, education and, most importantly, jobs which promote economic stability, growth and independence.

Because of the multiple barriers faced by this population, the community has come to rely on ACCESS' services to gain this economic security and independence. In addition, the business community has depended on ACCESS to refer qualified non-professional and professional minority candidates and to provide continued support once on the job if needed.

If ACCESS were not to be refunded, the impact on the community would be devastating. Indeed, without ACCESS' tailored assistance in obtaining and retaining employment, hundreds of able bodied and motivated individuals would not only be unemployed, but would suffer the consequences that result: bankruptcy, homelessness, poor nutrition, inadequate health care, etc.

Cambridge ACCESS Jobs, Inc. requests continued funding from the City of Cambridge in the amount of \$30,000 for its FY 1992 program.
