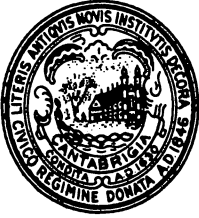


To the Honorable, the City Council:

The Public Investment Advisory Committee has recommended that the appropriation of \$176,000 in the Public Investment Fund for the "Chapter 76 Street Improvements" project be rescinded. This recommendation is based on the fact that during 1975-76, the Commonwealth's Department of Public Works discontinued the practice of third party contracts for state highway construction within Cambridge. Under the old system, the City would hire the contractor to perform the work and then be reimbursed by the County and the State. Under the new procedure, the State hires and pays the contractor itself but only after extensive consultation and review of the proposed work by the City's Public Works Commissioner.

Therefore, because highway construction funds no longer pass through our treasury, the appropriation is no longer required.

Passage of the attached order is recommended.
