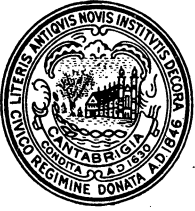

I hereby request an appropriation in the amount of \$51.53 to reimburse Robert W. Byrne, an employee of the Fire Department for damages in this amount.

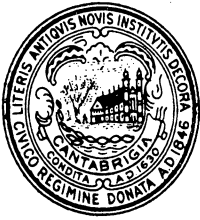
The Law Department, under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 41, Section 100-A, defended an action against Robert Byrne in which there was a judgment of \$51.53.


