RE: Arbor Day Celebration-"Kingsley Park"

I am pleased to report that the Massachusetts Arborist Association has selected the Cambridge Fresh Pond "Kingsley Park" to hold its eleventh annual Arbor Day Celebration on April 28th, 1990.

The Massachusetts Arborist Association member company's donate their services for the entire day to prune, thin, cable and brace. They will also remove dangerous trees and clean the entire "Kingsley Park" area, as well as planting of trees which are also donated. The completed arborcultural work is valued at \$45,000 and the estimated cost of the equipment on display is worth over 2.5 million dollars.

Each year the Massachusetts Arborist Association has increased the number of participants, this year we expect well over 25 certified tree companies to attend. Past sites have included the Arnold Arboreteum, the Boston Common, the Ruth Ipens tree walk in Belmont and last year's celebration was held at the Maudslay Estate in Newburyport, where 25 tree companies attended.

The main purpose of this exciting day is to promote proper arborcultural practice, as well as a shining symbol of faith in the future. It is a day set apart to encourage the planting and care of trees from which benefits will be derived for many years.
