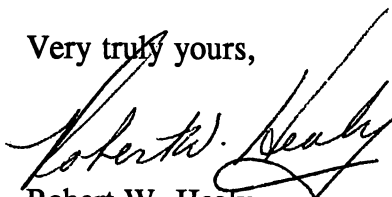

To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$72,000.00 to the Grant Fund from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to the Human Services Salary & Wages Account \$21,600.00 and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$50,400.00 to provide funds for improving the quality of existing emergency shelters for the homeless. The Preliminary plan for use of these funds is that \$46,800.00 will be subcontracted to shelter providers for repairs, and operating costs; \$21,600.00 will pay for the homeless population; and \$3,600.00 will be used for administration of the grant.
