The Office of Emergency Medical Services of the Massachusetts Department of Public Health is sponsoring the seventh annual Emergency Medical Services Week as a time to recognize the importance of this service; now therefore be it

That the Cambridge City Council do hereby proclaim the week of November 14 through November 20, 1982, Emergency Medical Services Week; and be it further
