WHEREAS: The Community Development Department of the City of Cambridge convened a group of over fifty service providers, housing developers and residents of the City to develop new housing programs for people with AIDS; and

WHEREAS: This working group, after significant deliberation, recommended that the City of Cambridge pursue funding to assist families living with AIDS by providing supportive housing, using a scattered site model; and

WHEREAS: Each of the members of this working group played an unique and crucial role in the realization of this goal; and

WHEREAS: Cambridge Cares About AIDS has developed an innovative service approach for families living with AIDS, the Cambridge Housing Authority has developed a plan to administer rental certificates to the families involved; and

WHEREAS: The Cambridge Hospital and the City of Cambridge Department of Human Services Programs has committed to provide matching service funding; and

WHEREAS: This unique partnership is poised to receive an allocation of \$450,000 in federal funds to provide not only housing, but supportive services for families living with AIDS; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council does hereby congratulate all of the individuals and organizations involved in this successful partnership, noting Cambridge Cares About AIDS, the Cambridge Housing Authority, the Cambridge Hospital, and the City of Cambridge Department of Human Services Programs, and recognizes their successful solicitation of funding for this important initiative.
