RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record proclaiming Thursday, November 21, 2002, one week before the traditional Thanksgiving, as **"FEED AMERICA THURSDAY"** and call upon the people of Cambridge to sacrifice, or fast, for two meals on Thursday, November 21, 2002, and to donate the money they would have spent on food to a charitable organization of their choice for the purpose of feeding the hungry.
