IN CITY COUNCIL

- WHEREAS: Mark Cunningham, a former employee of the Police Department of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the Police Department on March 13, 1927 and was pensioned on September 18, 1960 under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 83A, Sub-section A of the General Laws and died on December 13, 1979, having served not less than thirty-three years; and
- WHEREAS: At the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor his widow, Mrs. Mildred Cunningham, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 95A of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by Mark Cunningham, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Mildred Cunningham, widow of Mark Cunningham, of \$3,000.00 per year as long as she does not remarry.




