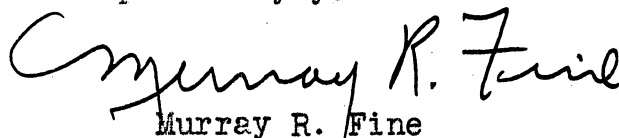

WHEREAS:-

An offer has been received by the City Council for the purchase of land on No. 33 and No. 35 Blanchard Road, it is

ORDERED:-

That His Honor, the Mayor, be and hereby is authorized, in the name of and in behalf of the City of Cambridge to sell and convey for a sum not less than five hundred (\$500) two parcels of land situated and described as follows:

No. 33 Blanchard Road; beginning at a point in the easterly line of Blanchard Road, said point being distant northerly (321.84) feet from the tangent point of a curve of (21.0) radius, which point is the intersection of the easterly line of Blanchard Road and the northerly line of Concord Avenue; thence northerly along said easterly line of Blanchard Road (20.0) feet to a corner; thence, turning and running northerly along division line between lots 17 and 18, (100) feet to a corner; thence, turning and running southerly along division line between lots 47 and 18, (20.0) feet to a corner; thence, turning and running westerly along division line between lots 19 and 18, (100.0) feet to a point in the easterly line of Blanchard Road at the point of beginning. Containing (2000) square feet more or less. All above measurements and area are more or less.

The above described parcel of land is shown as Lot No. 18 on Assessors Block Plan No. 267-B dated November 1936 and on file in Board of Assessors office, Cambridge, Mass.

No. 35 Blanchard Road; beginning at a point in the easterly line of Blanchard Road, said point being distant northerly (341.84) feet from the point of a curve of (21.0) feet radius, which point is the intersection of the easterly line of Blanchard Road and the northerly line of Concord Avenue; thence northerly along said easterly line of Blanchard Road (20.0) feet to a corner; thence turning and running northerly along division line between lots 16 and 17, (100) feet to a corner; thence, turning and running southerly (20) feet along division line between lots 48 and 17, to a corner; thence, turning and running westerly along division line between lots 18 and 17, (100) feet to a point in the easterly line of Blanchard Road at the point of beginning. Containing (2000) square feet more or less. All above measurements and area are more or less.

The above described parcel of land is shown as Lot No. 17 on Assessors Block Plan No. 267-B dated November 1936 and on file in Board of Assessors office, Cambridge, Mass.

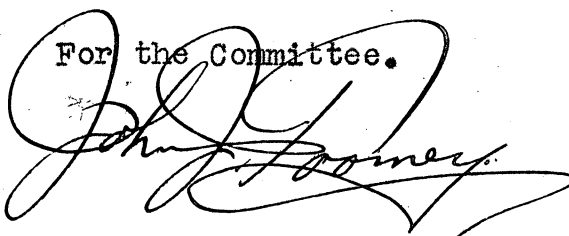
