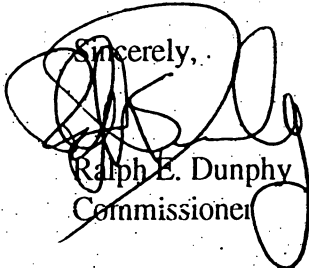
Dear Sheila:
