Dear Mr. Corcoran:

On January 23, 1973, a request from the hospital to you was made for preliminary appropriation of \$50,000.00 (D-2, food and ice), and \$150,000.00 (D-5, medical, surgical and laboratory supplies).

This request is of the utmost importance for the day to day operation of the hospital in supplying both dietary needs, and medical, surgical and laboratory supplies for the continued care of patients in the hospital. Failure to receive this appropriation will mean the refusal of vendors to supply the hospital because of unpaid bills.

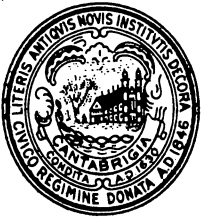
It has been necessary for us to transfer 1972 requisitions to 1973 requisitions in these two codes because of invoices outstanding in the amounts of fifty and one hundred thousand dollars, leaving us a deficit in this amount in our 1973-1974 budget. Further, we have been informed by the City Auditor that he will not process invoices in these codes until this preliminary appropriation is passed.

I appreciate your co-operation in this request and hopefully by the middle of next week we will be able to process these accounts for payment.
