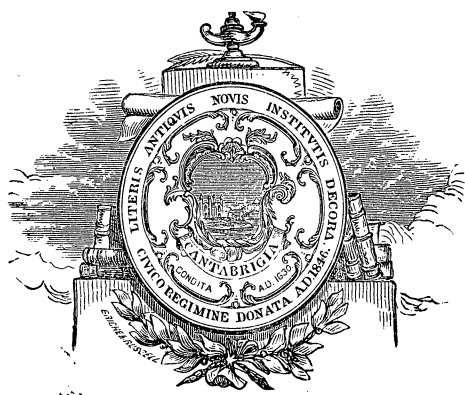




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

May 21. 1883

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Oak Street
from Cambridge street to the Lawrence line

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land

thirty
feet in width between Cambridge Street and the
Lawrence line

included between the red lines as shown on a plan drawn by Charles D. Elliot,
dated September 1875,

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that no damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid,
