I am writing to notify you that the MMA's Local Government Week is from September 23-27, 1996. Could Local Government Week be woven into the 150th Celebration?

I have in mind displays at a variety of locations showing how Cambridge government works. Examples of displays: water department video and display; library exhibit; community policing exhibit; recycling; the new public safety communications system; tree planting & community gardens; the emerging GIS system; Cambridge's web page; programs for children in Cambridge; Health of the City; voter registration; pedestrian and bicycle programs; affordable housing programs. There would be materials and rotating personnel at each location. Examples of locations: Galleria Mall, food store lobbies, fire and police stations, public libraries, city hall and annex, tables in Squares.

If you think this is a good idea, could we jointly sponsor a Council order for July 29?
