WHEREAS:

On June 21, 1982, this City Council voted to refer the proposal for a Mid-Cambridge Neighborhood Conservation District to the Community Development Department, for consultation among neighborhood residents with varying points of view; and

WHEREAS:

Although a "work group" has met several times in the more than two years since that time, no report has been made to the City Council; and

WHEREAS:

Substantial and detrimental physical change continues to occur in an unregulated manner throughout the Mid-Cambridge neighborhood; therefore, be it

ORDERED:

That the City Manager direct the Assistant City Manager for Community Development to make a final report on this matter in writing to the City Council not later than its meeting of October 29, 1984, or inform the City Council at that time that no such report is possible.
