Under date of April 17 1847

" Ordered That the Joint Standing
Committee on Roads and Bridges examine
and report upon the expediency of widening
Main Street on the Northerly side, from
a point near the junction of Mt Auburn
and Main Streets to the junction of Main
and Harvard Sts

Sent down for concurrence "

Under date of April 24 1847

" The following Papers came up
the Common Council having concurred in
the previous action of this Board. Orders,
widening of Main Street "

Under date of June 3 1847

" The Committee on Roads and
Bridges submitted a Report recommending
the widening of Main Street with the

following Order, which was adopted; -

Whereas, in the opinion of the Board, the safety and convenience of the inhabitants require that Main Street should be widened on its Northernly side, from the junction of Main and Harvard Streets, to a point a little Easterly of the junction of Main and Mount Auburn Streets, it is therefore hereby

Ordered, That due notice be given to the several persons whose land would be taken for said widening, and all other persons interested, that this Board intends to widen Main Street before mentioned, by taking a portion of their land, and laying out the same as a public street, and that Wednesday, the 19th day of June current, at 8 1/2 o'clock, P. M. is assigned as the time for hearing any objections which may be made thereto."

Under date of June 19. 1861

"The Special Assignment was taken up, viz. the hearing in the matter of widening Main Street.

Charles W. Huntington Esq. appeared for

Mrs. Anna L. Moring; Rev. D. C. Haskins
for Dr. Cogswell; J. Warren Merrill
for the Deacons of the Old Cambridge
Baptist Church, and John C. Stiles
for himself.

They were severally heard, and the
matter laid on the table."
