To the City Council.

The City Engineer, in compliance with an order passed May 19th directing an examination and survey for a new street proposed to be laid out from Mt. Auburn Street to the Cambridge Cemetery; having attended to the same, reports as follows.

The route surveyed extends from a point on Mt. Auburn Street opposite the Southerly end of Lowell Street, by the most practicable and a nearly direct course, Southwesterly to the North Easterly corner of the Cambridge Cemetery. The length on the centre line is 1692.7 ft. — 592.5 ft. of which is over land owned by Thompson Heirs and 1100.2 ft. over land of J. G. Coolidge. Its width is 40 ft. thus taking 23700.29 sq. ft. of land from the heirs of Thompson and 44008.29 sq. ft. from J. G. Coolidge. No allowance is made in the Estimate for any award of damages to these parties, because it

is believed that the opening of Raide street as contemplated would confer valuable advantages to Raide Estates far in excess of the worth of the land required, situated as it now is.

Accompanying this report is a plan of the street, together with a profile showing the proposed grade for the same, and the following is an estimate of Cost.
