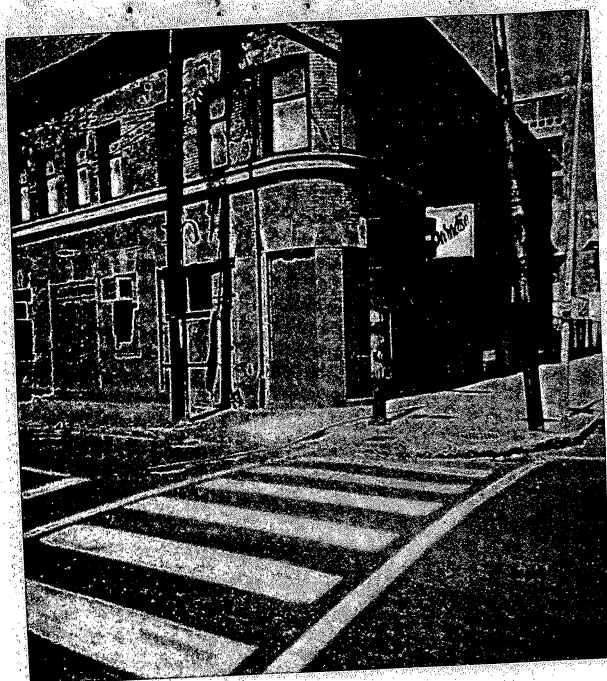
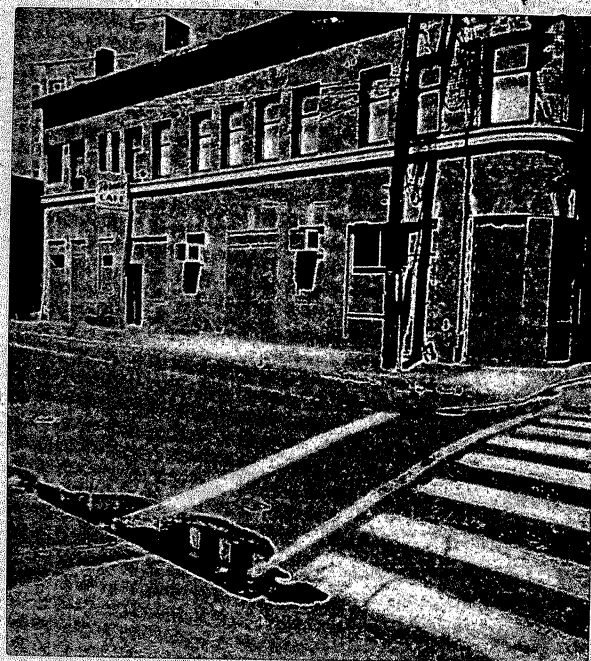

Avenue, Cambridge, Massachusetts.

Provided that, before erecting the above named awnings, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Inspectional Services Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Three Thousand (\$3,000.00) Dollars, conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the installation, maintenance and use of said three awnings.

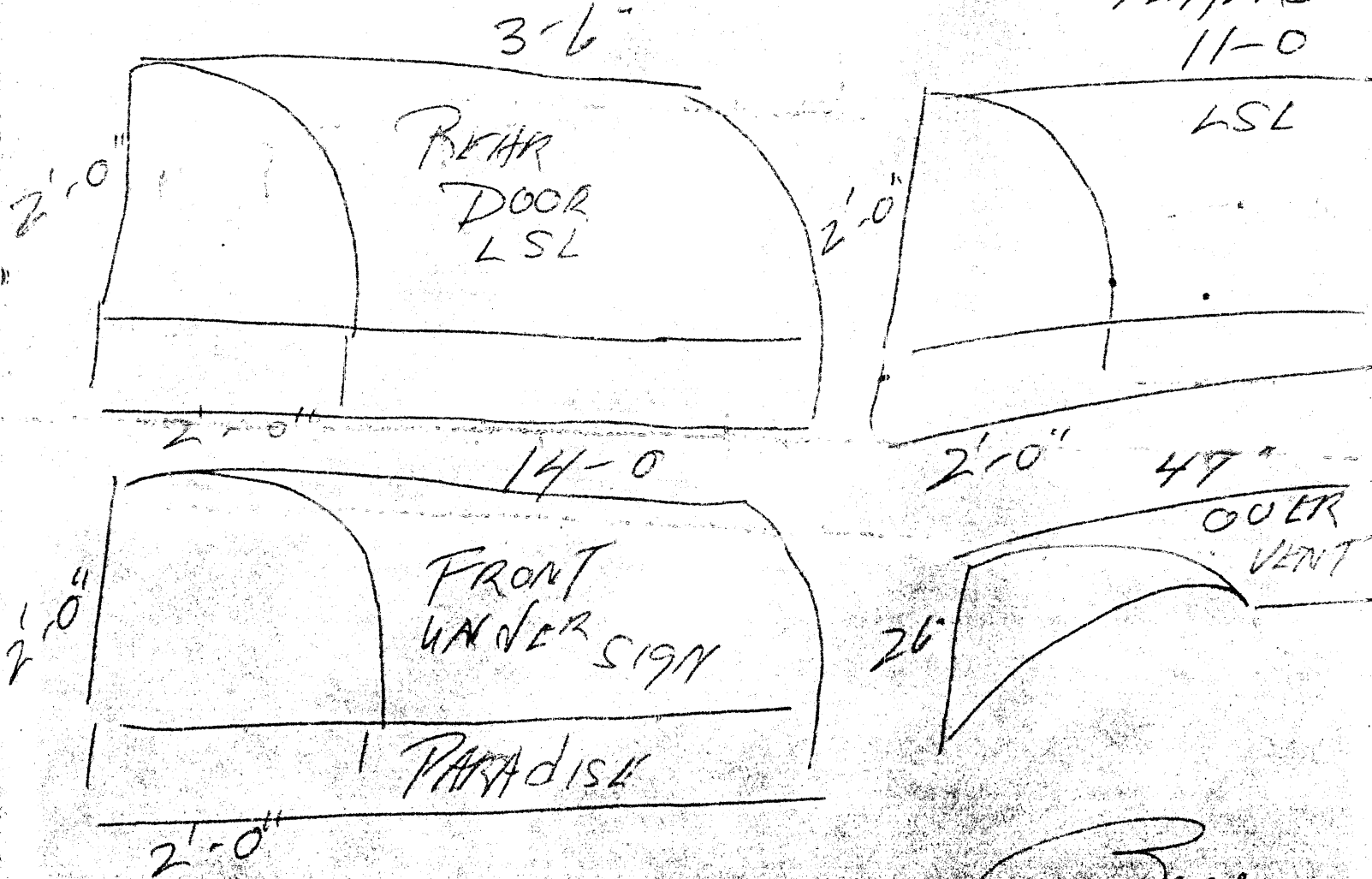
